## THANK YOU ALL FOR YOUR SUPPORT in 2018!

**Review of 2018:** Progress has been slow this year on the completion of **the maternity unit** and **operating theatre** in Uyogo. The government of Tanzania has continuing financial problems, but has budgeted money to be spent in 2018/19 for the completion of these projects, so we hope that in 2019 they will be up and running. Joyce Ongati, sponsored by KUFL through her medical studies at university, has agreed to be the medical officer. Unfortunately, Lucky Mgeni, our efficient local contact for several years, no longer works for Urambo district. Our new liaison is Godfrey Hisraeli, who is also a district water engineer. The **secondary school** is still to be completed, however when complete, Kenilworth School may contribute towards equipment for this.

KUFL sent money during the year to **Bees Abroad** towards the cost of a new hive workshop. Bees Abroad are trying to get more women in the village involved, and also to make honey production more profitable. Ino has graduated with a beekeeping diploma in Tabora. He spent 10 days in Uyogo in September training 50 – 60 people from Uyogo and surrounding villages. Johannes, from Uyogo, is starting a two year beekeeping certificate which Bees Abroad are funding. 35 top bar hives have bees and honey is being harvested.

During the year generous donations were received from Kenilworth School from their Africa week, from various churches in Kenilworth and from the 2 Castles Run (Rotary)

Beryl Starkey, a long standing supporter and committee member of KUFL for many years, moved to Chichester earlier this year. We miss her very much, but hope that she has settled in well at her new home.
